1. CCNUK welcome the inclusion of providing a key worker service for disabled children and their families and the support for the CCNUK key worker standards in chapter 5
2. CCNUK would encourage the inclusion of the provision of key worker services for disabled young people going through transition in chapter 6
3. On page 113, 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph Care Co-ordination Network should read Care Co-ordination Network UK. The website reference is also incorrect and should be replaced with [www.ccnuke.org.uk](http://www.ccnuke.org.uk)
4. CCNUK fully supports recommendation 5.4
5. CCNUK welcomes the recommendations in chapter 9 about the co-ordination of policy across government
